

... CrossLife Membership processes ...

A person/couple/family is encouraged to be regularly around the church for about six months so that we can get to know each other. Joining a small group or appropriate ministry is a key component here

CrossLife – a baptist church sends out a copy of key church documents and a membership info form in preparation for a “membership” visit and discussion with the person/couple/family.

The name/s then go to the Church Board who appoint a current church member to meet with you to discuss the church and your responses to the Membership Info form.

The church member will visit you and, with your input, prepare a written report to the Board.

The report goes back to the Board and at the next appropriate Board meeting a decision is made. This could be yes, or not yet, and either way you will be informed.

If the Board has agreed to the person/couple/family’s membership, It is then our practice to give notice of this pending admission to all members. Applicants are then welcomed into membership at the next appropriate church service.
